I am many times impacted by the events happening in the world to our families and churches both locally and internationally. I feel controlled by them, as though I were a pawn in their game because they all appear bigger than me. As the church of Christ, it is our responsibility to take advantage of the opportunity to bring "mass blessing" but how do we do this in the light of such opposition?

From the natural carnal man's standpoint this appears foolish, but from God's position He has called us to be co-workers with Him through the process of prayer; "YOUR KINGDOM COME, YOUR WILL BE DONE;" the weapons of our warfare are mighty through God to the pulling down of strongholds..."

We have relied on the wisdom of man. We organise and plan seminars, conferences, and programmes, but God is asking us to take the sword of prayer out of the sheath, clean it off and do battle for His Kingdom in the heavens as well as on earth.

God's power can only be released through prayer. We cannot change ourselves, but He changes us and the circumstance around us as we pray. God has His part and we have ours. In God's view, everything is provided, but we must take the sword of the Spirit and pray. We need Holy Spirit anointed prayer. He has delegated authority and power to His church but we stand impotent because we aren't using them!!! Since we have been so ineffective, the enemy of our souls has ravaged us, our homes, churches, bodies, and nations. But you say, "Isn't God sovereign; "the earth is the Lord's and the fullness thereof, the world and they that dwell therein?"

God GAVE the land of Canaan to the Israelites but it was full of wicked, cruel, demon worshipping tribes. What sort of gift is this?
