Militant Islam

The newly formed offspring of ISIS, ("the Islamic State") in Syria and Iraq has given all minority groups, including Christians the option to "convert to their version of Islam or die." They have circulated horrific pictures on the internet showing the brutal killing of either Shia or minority groups.

Because historical Christian records are not free of similar intolerant actions towards other segments of the church or Muslims it could be argued that, "He that is without sin, let him cast the first stone." Can we then with a clear conscience now condemn ISIS?
